#### **Features**


Time for networking with speakers, hosts, and special guests is built into the curriculum along with panel discussions, facilitated dialogue, and collaborative activities.





## **SERIES SCHEDULE**

- After orientation, subsequent sessions last between seven-toeight hours and open with an optional 30-minute networking coffee, which includes an International Center staff member host. This well attended component gives cohort members a chance to visit informally.
- Thirty- to 60-minute breaks and lunch are included throughout the day.




